Vividion Therapeutics is seeking a highly-motivated Research Associate to help support the operation of our proteomics platforms. Vividion is a privately held biotechnology company based in San Diego that is leveraging an innovative and proprietary chemical proteomics platform to efficiently discover novel drugs in areas such as oncology and immunology.

As an early stage startup company, Vividion is looking for energetic scientists with excellent communication skills and a desire to work in a fast-paced and dynamic team environment. The successful part-time candidate will be comfortable working with pure organic compounds, have a clear and demonstrable understanding of the basics of molecular structure for database uploads, measurement using modern hardware, and calculations necessary to prepare standard solutions for assay support.

This is a part-time, non-exempt position, working approximately 15-20 hours per week during normal business hours.

Specific tasks would include the following:

- Take newly prepared compounds (mostly solids in vials), register new compounds from outsource chemistry groups, and assign barcoded vials with internal compound registration ID's
- Split new compounds with sufficient mass into storage and dissolution samples. Store the un-dissolved sample for future retrieval.
- Prepare standard dmsO solutions, transfer to Micronics tubes, prepare dilution plates for assays, and upload plate maps using excel.
- Interface with analytical chemistry to assist with compound characterization via dmsO stocks.

- BS or BA in chemistry or biology with proven proficiency in organic chemistry labs
- Alternatively, exceptional undergrad experience while working towards an undergraduate degree but with proven laboratory based skills
